Anti-Racism Contact Officer

As part of the Department's commitment to anti-racism each school has a trained **Anti-Racism Contact Officer** (**ARCO**). At William Stimson Public School, our ARCO is **Miss Bojana Stegnjaic**.

The role of the ARCO is to:

- 1. Receive the suggestion, complaint or allegation regarding racism
- 2. Assist the complainant to write the complaint, if required
- 3. Advise the complainant of their rights and the process to be followed in lodging a complaint
- 4. Refer the complaint to a member of the school executive who will be responsible for resolving the complaint.

You will have seen some of these posters displayed around the school reminding students that racism hurts as well as notifying our students of who our ARCO is.


