Term 3 - Gymnastics Program

Following on from the success of the gymnastic program last year the school has booked Dance Fever Multisport to run



the exciting gymnastics program again this year for all students K-6. Whilst this program is costed at **\$28.00** for ten weeks, the school is offering to subsidise the program so that all students can participate.

The cost of the gymnastics program has been reduced to **\$20.00** for ten weeks.

Dance Fever Multisport will provide two qualified teachers who will teach the students balance, rotation, jumping and landing, swinging, locomotion, acrobatics partner poses and circus skills so that the students are provided with a large variety of equipment and skills to practice when exploring gymnastics. The program is structured for all ages and abilities and the students will not only learn the dominant movement patterns as mentioned above, but also the rules and safety aspects for each apparatus. The program is aligned with the PDHPE curriculum and the students will be assessed accordingly.

Dance Fever Multisport will also hold a 'Parent Performance' where families are invited to watch a gymnastics lesson to see what students have been learning and achieving during the term.
